The Guild's aim is to encourage and assist modellers working in all areas of 7mm railway modelling from narrow gauge to tinplate and from Finescale to ScaleSeven. Survival of the greatest

The story of popular O gauge began between the two world wars and was pioneered during the 1920s and 1930s by Hornby and Bassett-Lowke. When the Guild was formed in 1956 O gauge was rapidly being lost and was in danger of disappearing or at least becoming the preserve of the favoured few. Thankfully during the 1960s and 1970s 7mm modelling continued to grow, making the scale more accessible.

With over 5500 members including over 500 outside the UK, the Guild is now a focus for O Gauge modellers to meet, share and enjoy their mutual interest.

Membership benefits
